## 2010 Points of Interest

The number of crash fatalities in the district was lower than the three-year average with a significant reduction in the number of urban crash fatalities (17 fewer).

The district participates on fatal crash review boards in most counties to recommend measures to reduce crashes. The group in Medina County worked to close a dangerous county road intersection with a divided state route after a series of fatal crashes.


Troopers from the district worked with Lorain, Canton, Akron and Cleveland police departments on several enforcement efforts during the year. These combined efforts resulted in numerous traffic and criminal arrests.

Troopers initiated 299 felony cases in 2010, which represents a 14 percent increase.

The district's Commercial Enforcement Unit provided 11 trucking companies with safety presentations and maintained an ongoing partnership with Wooster Motor Ways.

The Wooster post commander belongs to the Amish Safety Committee and troopers are active in Amish Health and Safety Days, presenting traffic safety messages related to buggy and pedestrian safety.
