2010 Points of Interest

Post commanders routinely assigned patrols to identified high crash areas. Tactical squads were assigned to work areas with specific enforcement guidelines with a goal of crash reduction.


Crime prevention efforts were emphasized. The Dayton Post established a multi-agency operation to increase traffic safety and deter crime. The Dayton Metro Initiative was a series of enforcement blitzes focusing on high crash/high crime areas by troopers, the Montgomery County Sheriff and Dayton and Trotwood police.

OVI enforcement increased 8 percent as 3 percent of fatal crashes during 2010 involved an impaired driver.

Felony case investigations increased 50 percent. Troopers recorded a number of significant seizures of illegal drugs including 45 pounds of hydroponic marijuana valued at nearly \$500,000 during a traffic stop in Preble County. Tpr. Rich Barrett, a district canine handler, was named National Drug Interdiction Officer of the Year.

Sgt. Michael Hasson and Tpr. James Bryner, Marysville, were awarded Citations of Merit for their actions during and after the pursuit of an armed suspect who fired at law enforcement officers with a shotgun.
