






STOLEN VEHICLES IN OHIO

OSHP Stolen Vehicle Recoveries

- Over the last three years (2008-2010), OSHP Troopers have recovered 2,131 stolen vehicles throughout Ohio.
- Franklin County had the most stolen vehicle recoveries with 134. Other counties with large numbers of stolen vehicle recoveries were Cuyahoga (115), Trumbull (84), and Ashtabula (84). Combined, one of every five (20%) stolen vehicles was recovered in one of these four counties.
- During 2008-2010, 78 troopers earned the designation of "Ace." These troopers each recovered at least 5 stolen vehicles with an on-the-spot apprehension during a calendar year.

Ohio LEADS

- From January 2010 to February 2011, 5,633 stolen vehicles were entered into LEADS and have yet to be recovered.**
- At the county level, nearly one-third (32%) of the vehicles entered into LEADS were taken from either Cuyahoga (1,032) or Franklin (762) counties.
