





SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION INTERAGENCY COOPERATION

Post 78 Troopers received information from the Trumbull-Ashtabula-Geauga (TAG) drug task force to be on the lookout for a suspected drug carrier in a 1993 Honda Accord with PA plates on I80 in Trumbull Co. Suspect vehicle was stopped for a traffic violation and a PC search uncovered marijuana and drug paraphernalia. Driver willingly consented to a controlled delivery. Investigation by OSHP SRT and TAG officers at delivery site uncovered 2lbs of cocaine, 3lbs of marijuana, surveillance camera, prescription drugs, ammunition, 3 loaded weapons (including sub-machine gun), and numerous stolen items.

SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION LOOKING BEYOND THE LICENSE PLATE

During a routine license plate check of a 1993 Mercury Tracer, Trooper Pennington found that the plates belonged to another vehicle and attempted to perform a traffic stop. After a short pursuit, the driver exited the vehicle and ran towards the officer, who deployed his Taser to subdue the suspect. A BMV check revealed that the suspect's license had been suspended since 1986, he had numerous open license suspensions, and he had 15 prior lifetime OVI convictions. The intoxicated driver was charged with fictitious registration, felony fleeing, resisting arrest, and felony OVI.

- Criminal Arrest data for CASE, 75ARR, 75WAR, 76WAR, and 76SUM are from CAD dispositions. Data for 75SVR is from CAD dispositions (as of 04/01/2008) and from RIMS 410 cases. Data for DRUG, WEAP, IDENT, and RESIST are from CAD ORC entries.
- Identity theft ORCs (IDENT) were limited to 2913.31 (Forgery), 2921.13 (Falsification), and 2913.40 (Identify Fraud).

OSHP IDENTITY CRIMES

- From 2008-2009YTD (18 months), OSHP Troopers made 267 arrests for identity crimes. This includes 46 arrests for Forgery (17%), 102 arrests for Falsification (38%), and 134 arrests for Identity Fraud (50%).
- OSHP District 6 accounted for the largest number of arrests for identity crimes (43) during the 18-month time period, followed by District 3 (39) and District 8 (37). Post 9 Hamilton and Post 76 Canton recorded the highest number of arrests at the OSHP Post-level.
- At the County-level, Franklin had the most arrests related to identity crimes (29), followed by Butler (18), Lorain (18), and Stark (12). These four counties accounted for over one in four (28%) OSHP identity crime arrests.
- Nearly half of all identity crime arrests involved suspects with suspended licenses (128 or 48%); 54 involved impaired motorists (20%), 24 included drug arrests (9%), and 19 involved motor vehicle crashes (7%).
- Year-to-date (6 months), OSHP arrests for identity crimes are up 8% from 2008 levels.
