




## STATEWIDE REPORTED TRAFFIC FATALITIES 01/01/2009 – 09/20/2009



### SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION LOOKING BEYOND THE LICENSE PLATE

Trooper Simms stopped a 2000 Jeep Grand Cherokee with IL plates for an unsafe lane change on I70 in Preble County. Numerous criminal indicators and a positive canine alert led to a probable cause search that revealed a total of 1,198 bootleg CDs located in six boxes in the back of the vehicle. The owner of the vehicle was charged with Counterfeiting, Theft, and Forgery.

### SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION LOOKING BEYOND THE LICENSE PLATE

Troopers stopped a 1999 Freightliner commercial motor vehicle with TX plates for a marked lanes violation on I70 in Preble County. Numerous criminal indicators and a positive canine alert led to a probable cause search of the vehicle's trailer. Officers uncovered 45 kilogram packages of suspected cocaine valued at \$4.5 million concealed in two boxes of lettuce within the vehicle.

- Identity theft ORCs (IDENT) were limited to 2913.31 (Forgery), 2921.13 (Falsification), and 2913.40 (Identify Fraud).



### OSHP ILLEGAL WEAPON ARRESTS

- From 2008-2009YTD (20 months), OSHP Troopers made 447 arrests for illegal weapons. OSHP District 9 accounted for the largest number of arrests for illegal weapons (85) during the 20-month time period, followed by District 3 (59) and District 6 (55). Post 76 Canton (25) and Post 71 Chillicothe (24) recorded the highest number of arrests at the OSHP Post-level.
- At the County-level, Richland and Ross had the most arrests related to illegal weapons (24 each), followed by Scioto (18), Mahoning (17), and Stark (17). These five counties accounted for over one in five OSHP illegal weapon arrests (100 or 22%).
- Over half of all illegal weapon arrests involved felonies (233 or 52%); 173 involved impaired motorists (39%), 120 included drug arrests (27%), and 80 were motorists with suspended licenses (18%).

NOTE: 2008-2009YTD includes OSHP arrests that occurred between 1/1/2008-8/31/2009. District 6 includes OSHP General Headquarters.
