TIPS TO STAY SAFE

- Wear your seat belt!**
- Minimum following distance between two vehicles is 1 car length per 10 MPH.**
- Make sure to stay alert and watch traffic.**
- Avoid being distracted by the radio, cell phone or other occupants in the vehicle.**
