




## SCHOOL BUS SAFETY

### School Bus Crashes

- From 2008-2010, 5,192 crashes involving school buses occurred on Ohio's roadways, an average of 1,731 per year. This includes 15 fatal crashes as well as 816 injury crashes.
- Eighteen people were killed in fatal school bus related crashes from 2008-2010. Of these, only one (6%) was an occupant of the school bus.
- School bus related crashes resulted in 1,964 injuries from 2008-2010. Sixty-two percent (62%) of the injured persons were school bus occupants.
- School bus drivers were in error in crashes at about the same rate as the drivers of other vehicles (44% vs. 46%). Nine percent (9%) of crashes had no error while 1% were caused by animals.

### Passing Stopped School Buses

- From 2008-2010, 4,438 drivers\* were convicted of failing to stop for a school bus that was loading or dropping off passengers. OSHP troopers wrote 1,404 such citations during that time.

### School Bus Inspections

- One of the Highway Patrol's duties is to conduct annual school bus inspections for the state of Ohio. From 2008-2010, OSHP performed 140,179 school bus inspections, an average of 46,726 per year.
