

### Crashes Involving At-Fault Teen Drivers\*

- From 2011-2013, teen drivers were involved in 135,473 traffic crashes in Ohio. A teen driver was at-fault in 73% (99,132) of these crashes. At-fault teen crashes resulted in 288 fatalities and 43,785 injuries, and represent 9% of all fatal crashes during this time.
- Speed-related factors contributed to more than half (58%) of crashes caused by teen drivers. For fatal crashes, more than one-quarter (29%) of at-fault teen drivers were alcohol or drug impaired.
- Male teenage drivers were more likely than females to be at-fault in crashes (56% vs. 44%). In more than two-thirds (69%) of teen at-fault crashes, the teen driver was the sole occupant of the vehicle.

### Teen Traffic Citations by OSHP

- From 2011-2013, OSHP Troopers wrote 115,373 citations to teen drivers. Of these, 71,846 (62%) included a speeding violation and 20,009 (17%) involved safety belt violations. Only 3% (2,931) of citations included an impaired driving offense.
- More than half (52%) of citations given to teen drivers were written on a Friday, Saturday or Sunday. Nearly one-fourth (23%) of citations were written during the after-school hours from 2:00 p.m. to 6:59 p.m. Monday-Friday.
