




On 2/18/2009, Trooper Roe stopped a commercial motor vehicle for a traffic violation. Prior to the stop, the officer noted that there were 2 occupants in the cab. Upon approach, the passenger moved to the sleeper cab and covered her face. Subsequent investigation revealed that the driver, male suspect age 38, had met the juvenile passenger, female age 17, on the Internet. He had picked her up the prior night at 10pm and was enroute to West Virginia. Further investigation by Trooper Roe uncovered illegal/inappropriate photos on the suspect's cell phone. Charges are being filed by the Marion Co Prosecutor's Office for Illegal use of a minor in nudity oriented material or performance (ORC:2907.323a3).



AGGRESSIVE DRIVING: 20+ mph Over the Speed Limit

Speeding 20 or more miles above the posted speed limit is considered a dangerous form of aggressive driving. The following pages provide statistics on OSHP citations given to 20+ mph drivers.

2008 Statistics

- In 2008, the Ohio State Highway Patrol issued a total of 74,507 citations for driving 20 mph or greater over the posted speed limit.
- Ohio Turnpike Troopers (District 10) were responsible for nearly one in five (13,198/18%) OSHP-issued citations for driving 20 mph or greater over the speed limit in 2008. District Eight was close behind (12,907/17%), followed by District Six (9,027/12%), District Three (8,698/12%), and District Five (7,753/10%).
- At the county level, Hamilton had the most 20+ citations in 2008 (4,797), followed by Sandusky (3,111), Franklin (2,838), Erie (2,593), and Lorain (2,523).
- More than one-third (38%) of 20+ citations in 2008 were issued on Saturday or Sunday. For all days of the week, 9:00-11:59 a.m. and 3:00-5:59 p.m. were busiest for 20+ citations (accounting for 42% of the total).
- Of the total traffic stops resulting in a 20+ citation, 850 also included an OVI¹ arrest; 709 involved a driver of a commercial vehicle; and 1,543 involved a violation for driving under a suspended license.

2009 Statistics

- To date in 2009² OSHP has issued 7,829 citations for driving 20+ mph over the speed limit. Saturday and Sunday remain the busiest (38% of 20+ citations). For all days of the week, 9:00-11:59 a.m. and 3:00-6:00 p.m. remain the busiest, accounting for nearly half (47%) of 20+ citations.
