




## STATEWIDE REPORTED TRAFFIC FATALITIES 01/01/2009 – 06/14/2009



### SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION INTERAGENCY COOPERATION

In early June, OSHP SRT White Team members were assigned to the United State Marshal's Operation Falcon detail in Youngstown, Ohio. The operation was responsible for 22 arrests of wanted felons. Task force members made additional arrests for drugs, guns, and grenades as a result of the detail.

On 5/29/09, Trooper Gaskill was dispatched to a two vehicle crash on I77 in Tuscarawas Co. The driver of one of the vehicles fled on foot and was stopped shortly afterwards by Sgt. Fetty. Numerous items (used coffee filters, coffee pot, pseudophedrine, tubing, funnels, glass jars, cat litter, etc.) used in the manufacturing of methamphetamine were discovered within the vehicle. BCI&I was contacted and took over the investigation of the mobile meth lab. Eagle Construction was contacted to clear the hazardous scene and items for the investigation were sent to the OSHP and BCI&I crime labs for further analysis.

Map: 2006-2008 Motorcyclist Citations by the Highway Patrol



### 2006-2008 Motorcycle Statistics:

#### OHIO CRASHES

- There were 215 motorcycle-related crash fatalities in Ohio in 2008. This is the highest number of annual motorcycle-involved fatalities in the 25 years for which data are available.
- From 2006 to 2008 motorcycle-involved crashes resulted in a total of 562 fatalities and 12,032 injuries statewide.
- The yearly average number of motorcycle-involved fatalities from 2006 to 2008 was 187, a 26% increase compared to the 2003-2005 average (149 fatalities per year).
- Forty percent (40%) of motorcyclists involved in fatal crashes from 2006-2008 were alcohol- or drug-impaired.

#### OSHP CITATIONS

- OSHP troopers administered 8,070 citations to motorcyclists from 2006 to 2008 (see map above). Annual citations increased during that time: there were 34% more motorcyclist citations in 2008 compared to 2006.
- Citations for driving a motorcycle without an appropriate operator license or endorsement increased by 32% from 2006 to 2008. Overall, license/endorsement violations accounted for one in five (21%) motorcyclist citations.
- Over forty percent (43%) of motorcyclist citations included speeding violations (speeding violations increased by 25% from 2006 to 2008); eleven percent (11%) of motorcyclist citations included an OVI arrest.
- The number of citations has been increasing for all age groups, but especially upper age groups: citations given to 46-55 year olds rose by 43%, and citations given to 56-65 year olds rose by 73% from 2006 to 2008.

#### OHIO MOTORCYCLE REGISTRATIONS\*

- The number of annual motorcycle registrations increased in every Ohio county from 2006 to 2008 (16% statewide). In 33 of Ohio's 88 counties motorcycle registrations increased by 20% or greater. The lowest percent increase was 10% (5 counties); the highest increases were in Morgan (38%), Gallia (31%), and Meigs (30%) counties.
