





SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSION LOOKING BEYOND THE LICENSE PLATE

Trooper Mularcik received a BOLO request from Sidney PD for a 1997 Chevy Cavalier with multiple suspects that were involved in an armed robbery. The vehicle was identified and OSHP coordinated a multi-agency effort (OSHP Dayton and Piqua, Shelby CSO, Sidney PD, Vandalia City PD) to minimize the chance of a pursuit and assure a safe felony traffic stop was performed. Suspects were apprehended without incident.

Trooper Dobbins stopped a 1997 Cadillac Deville on SR170 in Mahoning Co for driving with no headlights. The driver was unable to produce an OL and gave a false name and DOB to the officer. After numerous failed attempts to identify the suspect, he was incarcerated. The suspect eventually identified himself and an inquiry in LEADS revealed that the suspect was wanted for homicide in Oakland, CA.

Trooper Seabolt observed a 1997 Chevy Caprice with 3 adults and 3 unrestrained children in the backseat of a vehicle on US23 in Pike Co. Upon approach, the female driver admitted to having a suspended OL and was extremely nervous. Trooper Mikesh and K9 Marco were called to the scene. A positive alert and a PC search revealed 5 syringes and a small amount of hydromorphone and black tar heroin in the vehicle. The 3 children (under 5) were released to a grandparent and suspect was incarcerated.



2006-2008

- The Ohio Bureau of Motor Vehicles (BMV) reports 183,362 convictions statewide from 2006-2008 for driving under a suspended license (DUS).² During the 3-year period OSHP issued a total of 84,632 DUS citations.
- District 8 troopers issued the highest number of DUS citations from 2006-2008 (12,082), followed by District 9 (11,652) and District 6 (10,968).
- A large proportion of DUS citations by OSHP took place at night and on weekends: 28% were issued between 5 p.m. Friday and 5 p.m. Sunday; 34% of DUS citations were issued between 9 p.m. and 3 a.m. (all days).
- Younger age groups comprised the majority of cited DUS offenders: thirty-four percent (34%) were age 25 or below; an additional thirty-four percent (34%) were age 26 to 35.
- A multitude of additional offenses accompanied DUS violations: 18% of citations included OVI violations; 25% included speeding violations; 29% included safety belt violations; and 9% involved a crash.

2009 Statistics

- Through September 30, OSHP issued 20,518 total DUS citations (see map and table above). Thus far, 2009 figures are largely consistent with previous years' data, in regard to time and day of offenses, as well as additional violations:
 - Thirty-eight percent (38%) of DUS violations occurred between 5 p.m. Friday and 5 p.m. Sunday; thirty-three percent (33%) took place between 9 p.m. and 3 a.m. (all days).
 - Seventeen percent (17%) of DUS citations included OVI arrests; 25% included speeding citations, and 25% included safety belt violations.

¹ There were 23 citations from 2006-2008 for which no county/district information was identified. 2009 data is provisional through September 30.

² BMV conviction codes include (7) "Driving Under Suspension"; (22) "Driving Under FRA Suspension"; (73) "Driving Under OVI Suspension"; and (AO) "Driving Under 12 Pt. Suspension."
