


SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSIONS

Trooper Bingman	The Swanton Post received an alert from the Orland Park IL PD of a suspected kidnapping of a 2-year old girl by three adults (father and two friends). The suspect vehicle was stopped en route to JFK airport in NY via the I80 Ohio Turnpike. The primary suspect, the girl's father, was an undocumented Jordanian national that was attempting to flee the country with his daughter. The suspect vehicle had suitcases, cash, new clothes, and illegal passports that were going to be used for the trip. The 2-year old daughter was unharmed and safely returned to her mother. The three suspects were charged with felony kidnapping.

Trooper Simms	The Butler CSO contacted District 5 DHQ and requested a canine unit to sniff the outside of a suspect 2000 Ford Taurus. Trooper Simms responded to the scene and K9 Lady gave a positive alert to the bumper at the back of the car. In the trunk of the vehicle, officers located two false compartments that contained a total of 7 kilos of cocaine with an estimated street value of \$700,000. Butler CSO seized the evidence and took the suspects into custody.



2005-2007 Holiday Season¹ OVI-Related Crash and Enforcement Statistics:

- A total of 6,077 OVI crashes occurred during the (combined) 2005, 2006, and 2007 Holiday Seasons, including 104 fatal crashes and 2,430 injury crashes.
- Counties having the highest number of Holiday Season OVI crashes include Cuyahoga (534), Franklin (523), Hamilton (394), Summit (316) and Montgomery (265). See map above.
- Over half (52%) of Holiday Season OVI crashes took place between 9:00 p.m. and 3:00 a.m.; fifty-seven percent (57%) occurred on Friday, Saturday, and Sunday.
- Forty-five percent (45%) of impaired drivers who were at fault in Holiday Season OVI crashes were 30 years of age or younger; more than half (56%) were 35 years of age or younger.
- OSHP investigated over half (56%) of fatal OVI crashes and 35% of injury OVI crashes occurring on Ohio roadways during the 2005, 2006, and 2007 Holiday Seasons.
- In Holiday Season OVI crashes investigated by OSHP, known BAC (blood alcohol concentration) levels exceeded the legal limit of .08 in the majority of cases: only 10% of at-fault impaired drivers registered below the legal limit; 83% registered .10 or higher; 50% registered .15 or higher; and one in five (21%) registered .20 or higher.
- OSHP Troopers make an average of 2,829 OVI arrests each year, statewide, during the Holiday Season.

¹ "Holiday Season" is defined as the period beginning the day before Thanksgiving and ending January 2 of the following new year. OVI = Operating a Vehicle Impaired.
