


SIGNIFICANT HIGHWAY PATROL APPREHENSIONS

OFFICER	DESCRIPTION
OSHP Trooper Hurler	Trooper Hurler stopped a 1996 Toyota Camry with three occupants on SR 41 in the city of Washington Court House (Fayette County) for a vehicle defect (cracked windshield). Conflicting stories and various criminal indicators led to a PC search of the vehicle by WCHPD Officer Hughes and K9 Vido. On the rear floorboard, officers noticed two air tank gauges/air fill hose next to a backpack that contained a hose, pliers, and tape. In the trunk of the vehicle, officers located two black air tanks covered in frost, indicating the presence of Anhydrous Ammonia. A DEA HAZMAT Team was called to the scene to secure and take possession of the "mobile meth lab." All three suspects were arrested for Possession of Criminal Tools and Illegal Assembly. One of the suspects also had several outstanding warrants, including one for felony drug possession.

COMMERCIAL MOTOR VEHICLE FACTS:

Arrests OSHP Troopers made 34,711 commercial motor vehicle arrests of 70-mph or more over the last three years (2005-2007).

Out-of-Service Violations Ohio law enforcement personnel issued nearly 120,000 commercial vehicle out-of-service violations over the last three years (2005-2007). Half of these violations (50 Percent) were related to brakes, tires/wheels, or steering/suspension – all areas that can have an impact on the stopping ability of commercial motor vehicles.

Crashes Overall, commercial motor vehicles were found to be at-fault in 55 percent of crashes that involve passenger and commercial vehicles (2005-2007). Commercial vehicle drivers were found to be at-fault in nearly one in three speed-related crashes involving passenger and commercial vehicles.

2006 Ohio Turnpike and Alternate Routes Project Outcomes In 2006, OSHP researchers released results of the *Ohio Turnpike and Alternate Routes Project* that studied the effects of raising commercial motor vehicle speeds from 55-mph to 65-mph on the Ohio Turnpike. During comparable time frames, results showed that commercial vehicle crashes increased 40 percent (230 total crashes), and at-fault speed-related commercial crashes increased 123 percent (38 total crashes) following the speed limit increase.
