Motorcycle fatalities have risen 40 percent statewide in the last three years with 190 fatalities in 2007 alone. In this area in 2006/07 there were 136 motorcycle crashes, killing 11 and injuring 113.

Motorcycle Crash Information Marysville Post



This fatal motorcycle crash occurred on County Road 10 in Champaign County. The driver of this motorcycle was killed when he failed to negotiate a curve and drove off the side of the roadway, striking a utility pole head-on. The motorcyclist tested a .22 blood-alcohol content, nearly three-times the prohibited concentration.

Did you know...

In this area in 2006/07 more than fifty percent of the fatal motorcycle crashes were OVI-related, killing 6 people?
