## **Sergeant Landis to serve as Patrol spokesperson**

COLUMBUS- Sergeant Jeremy T. Landis of the Ohio State Highway Patrol's Georgetown Post has transferred to the Public Affairs Unit as part of a 90-day program, in which he will temporarily serve as a spokesperson for the Patrol.

Sgt. Landis earned his Bachelor of Arts degree from Maryville College in May 1996. He joined the Patrol a year later as a member of the 129<sup>th</sup> Academy Class. He was commissioned that November and assigned to the Batavia Post. In December 2002 he transferred to the Wilmington District Office of Investigations. In July 2005 he was promoted to the rank of sergeant and transferred to the Georgetown Post to serve as an assistant post commander.
