Man arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Allen Correctional Institution

LIMA - A Fort Recovery man is scheduled to appear in Lima Municipal Court today on a felony charge after he was found attempting to convey illegal narcotics into the grounds of the Allen Correctional Institution yesterday.

Troopers said Walter J. Call II, 47, was charged with conveying drugs into a correctional facility, a third-degree felony.

Department of Rehabilitation and Correction investigators received information that an unidentified individual was planning to deliver drugs onto the grounds of the Allen Correctional Institution. Troopers set up surveillance and observed the suspect leave the drugs in the suspected drop-off point on the facilities grounds. Troopers subsequently arrested the suspect and recovered methamphetamines, marijuana, oxycotin tablets, weight lifting supplements and cell phones.

Call was incarcerated at the Allen County Jail. If convicted, he could face up to five years in prison and a \$10,000 fine.
