Purpose: This course is to introduce road patrol officers to advanced criminal patrol interdiction training techniques while enforcing Ohio's criminal laws during the course of a traffic stop. Topics will focus on Change in Driving Behavior / Unusual Driving Behavior, Questioning and Evaluating / Rapid Assessment, False and Hidden Compartments and Large Vehicle / Commercial Vehicle Interdiction.

Who should attend: Patrol officers and supervisors.

Instructors: The instructors for this course will be provided by the OSHP Criminal Patrol Unit and include Sergeant Shaun Smart, Sergeant Stacey Arnold and Trooper Breck Williamson. All three officers are certified instructors through the Drug Interdiction Assistance Program (DIAP).
