Cincinnati woman arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Lebanon Correctional Institution

LEBANON- A Cincinnati woman will appear in Lebanon Municipal Court today after Ohio State Highway Patrol troopers arrested her yesterday for conveying drugs into the Lebanon Correctional Institution.

Troopers charged Aisha Horton, 25, with conveying drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony, and possession of criminal tools, a fifth-degree felony.

Troopers and Department of Rehabilitation and Correction Investigators obtained information that Horton would be conveying drugs to her inmate friend during their scheduled visit. Investigators observed Horton switching shoes with the inmate during their visit, and a subsequent search revealed 4 baggies of marijuana, weighing approximately 154 grams, hidden in the gym shoes.

Horton was incarcerated in the Warren County Jail. If convicted, she could face up to seven years in prison and a \$15,000 fine.

The Ohio State Highway Patrol investigates criminal activity on state-owned and leased property.
