Sergeant Ralston to serve as Patrol spokesperson

COLUMBUS- Sergeant Anne R. Ralston of the Ohio State Highway Patrol's Marietta Post has transferred to the Public Affairs Unit as part of a 90-day program, in which she will temporarily serve as a spokesperson for the Patrol.

Sgt. Ralston graduated Youngstown State University in 1996 with a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice. She joined the Patrol in April 1998 as a member of the 131st Academy Class. She was commissioned that October and assigned to the Fremont Post. In March 2000 she transferred to the Cambridge Post, where in 2002 she was named Post Trooper of the Year by her peers and also earned an Ace Award for excellence in auto larceny enforcement. In October 2004 she was promoted to the rank of sergeant and transferred to the Marietta Post to serve as an assistant post commander.

Sgt. Ralston currently resides in Caldwell.
