### **Two Dayton women arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Warren Correctional Institution**

LEBANON – Two Dayton women are scheduled to appear in Lebanon Municipal Court today on a felony charges after attempting to convey drugs into the Warren Correctional Institution today.

Troopers charged Richetta M. Worthy, 36, and Shameka D. McIntosh, 28, with conveying drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony, possession of criminal tools, a fifth-degree felony, and possession of drugs, a fifth-degree felony. Both women had a scheduled visit with the same inmate.

Troopers and Department of Rehabilitation and Correction investigators obtained information that Worthy would be conveying drugs to her boyfriend during their scheduled visit. A Search Warrant was obtained through the Warren County Common Pleas Court. During the search, Worthy was found to have approximately 1 gram of Heroin in her pocket, and McIntosh was found to have 4 grams of marijuana in her mouth. Nineteen more grams of marijuana and 12 pills were also found in their car parked in the parking lot.

Worthy and McIntosh are incarcerated in the Warren County Jail. If convicted, they could face up to seven years in prison and a \$15,000 fine.
