Xenia woman arrested for Illegal Drug Conveyance at Warren Correctional Institution

LEBANON - A Xenia woman appeared in Lebanon Municipal Court yesterday after Ohio State Highway Patrol troopers arrested her Wednesday for attempting to convey drugs into the Warren Correctional Institution (WCI).

Troopers charged Bambi Kukuk, 28, with attempting to convey drugs onto the grounds of a detention facility, a third-degree felony, and possession of criminal tools, a fifth-degree felony.

Troopers and Department of Rehabilitation and Correction Investigators obtained information that Kukuk would be attempting to convey drugs to her boyfriend, an inmate at WCI, during their scheduled visit. Kukuk was caught with 20 grams of marijuana wrapped in electrical tape, concealed in her bra.

Kukuk was incarcerated in the Warren County Jail. If convicted, she could face up to seven years in prison and a \$15,000 fine.
