“Operation Safe Student” to focus on motor coach safety *Inspections at Kings Island and Cedar Point*

COLUMBUS – With the increase of student field trips this time of year, the Ohio State Highway Patrol will be joining the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration for “Operation Safe Student” starting tomorrow through May 21.

The campaign aims to ensure that passenger carrier motor vehicle drivers are operating within federal motor carrier safety regulations and that the motor coaches are safe to drive on Ohio roadways.

Motor Carrier Enforcement Inspectors and Troopers will focus their efforts on inspections at Cedar Point and Kings Island. Statewide troopers will focus on traffic safety enforcement of passenger carrier motor vehicles.
