Public's assistance sought for walk-away patient from Northcoast Behavioral Healthcare System

CLEVELAND – The Ohio State Highway Patrol is seeking the public's assistance in locating Michael T. Cummings, a patient of the Northcoast Behavioral Healthcare System, in Northfield, that walked away from the institution today between Noon and 12:30 p.m. while he was being permitted to have grounds privileges.

Cummings, 49, of Akron, is a white male, 5'9", weighing 212 pounds. He has grey hair, hazel eyes and short grey beard. He was last seen wearing a black t-shirt, sweatpants and green crock shoes.

Cummings was committed to the behavioral center by a court order for not guilty by reason of insanity for burglary and breaking and entering charges.
