### **Sergeant Reeder to serve as Patrol spokesperson**

COLUMBUS- Sergeant Richard P. Reeder of the Ohio State Highway Patrol's Sandusky Post has transferred to the Public Affairs Unit as part of a 90-day program, in which he will temporarily serve as a spokesperson for the Patrol.

Sgt. Reeder joined the Patrol in April 1998 as a member of the 131<sup>st</sup> Academy Class. He was commissioned that October and assigned to the Norwalk Post. In July 2004 he transferred to the Sandusky Post. He was promoted to the rank of sergeant in May 2007 and transferred to the Piqua Post, to serve as an assistant post commander. In April 2008 he transferred back to the Sandusky Post.

A 1994 graduate of Plymouth High School, Sgt. Reeder earned a Bachelor of Science degree in Criminal Justice from Bluffton College in May 1998.

Originally of Shiloh, Sgt. Reeder currently resides in Norwalk with his wife, Michelle.
