Springfield Patrol Post investigating multiple fatality crash on Interstate 70, I-70 eastbound closed

SPRINGFIELD – The Springfield Post of the Ohio State Highway Patrol is currently investigating a fatal crash on Interstate 70 eastbound near milepost 62 in Clark County. Four are confirmed dead.

A commercial vehicle traveling westbound on I-70 lost control and crossed the median into eastbound traffic, clipping a car and crashing into a 17-passenger motor coach, killing the driver and three passengers and injuring six others. The six injured in the motor coach and the driver of the commercial vehicle were transported to a local hospital. The driver of the car was not injured.

Interstate 70 eastbound is closed. Traffic is being redirected onto US 41.

Identities of those killed will be released pending next-of-kin notification.
